Meet Jackie: Circulation Clerk!

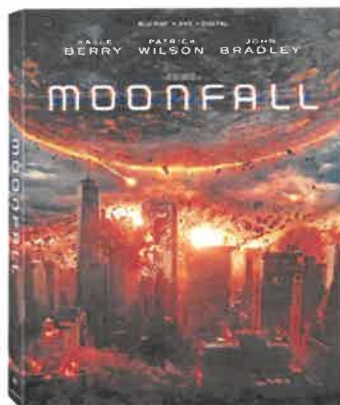

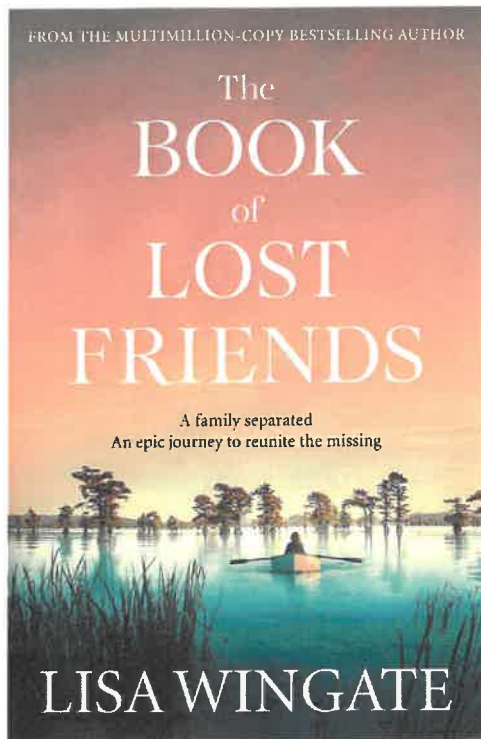


New! We were given 3 [backpacks for the Special Olympics Indiana Young Athletes Library program .](#)

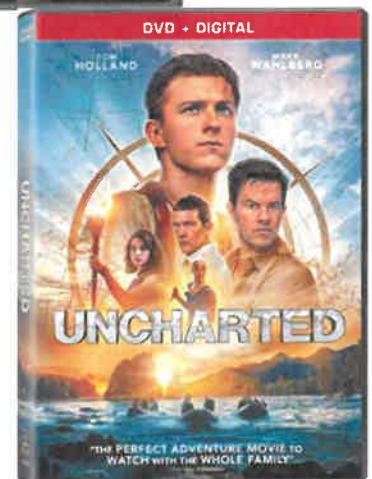
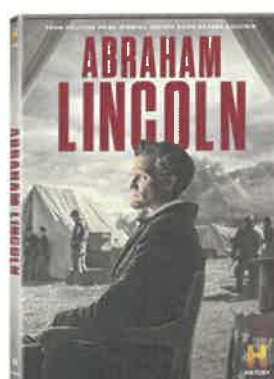
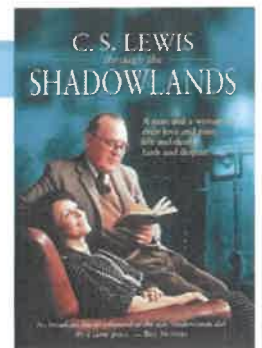
