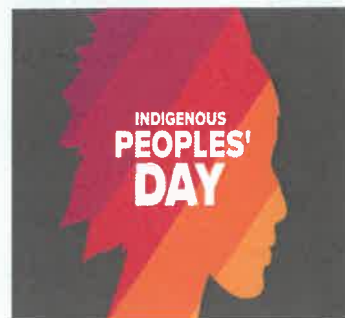

Make Your Own Monsters:

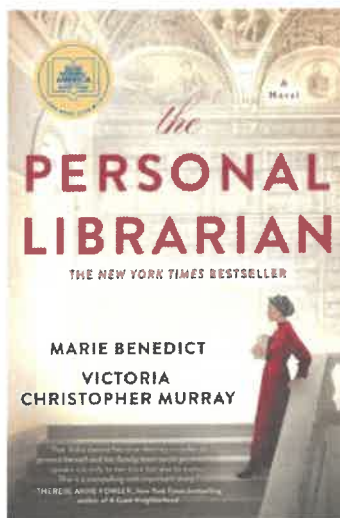

Checking In

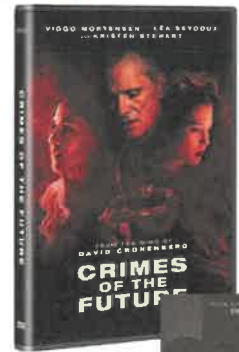
- Participants will click "Check-In" at the bottom of the library's listing.
