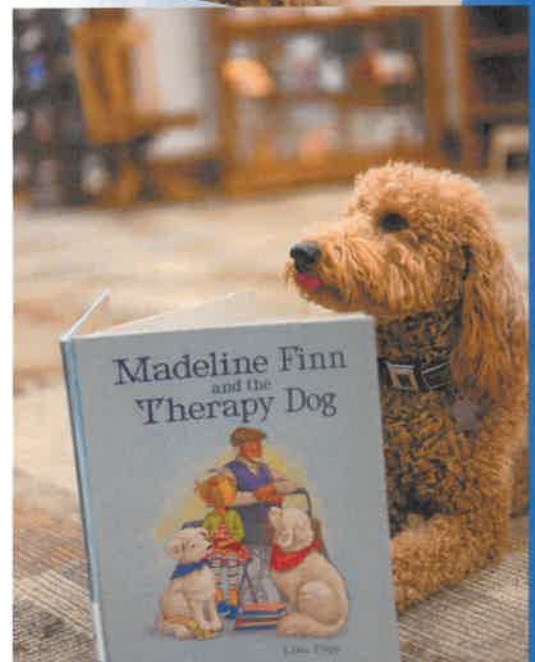
### *It's Paisley's Page !!*
