Adults—For every five books you read, you will get your choice of a prize

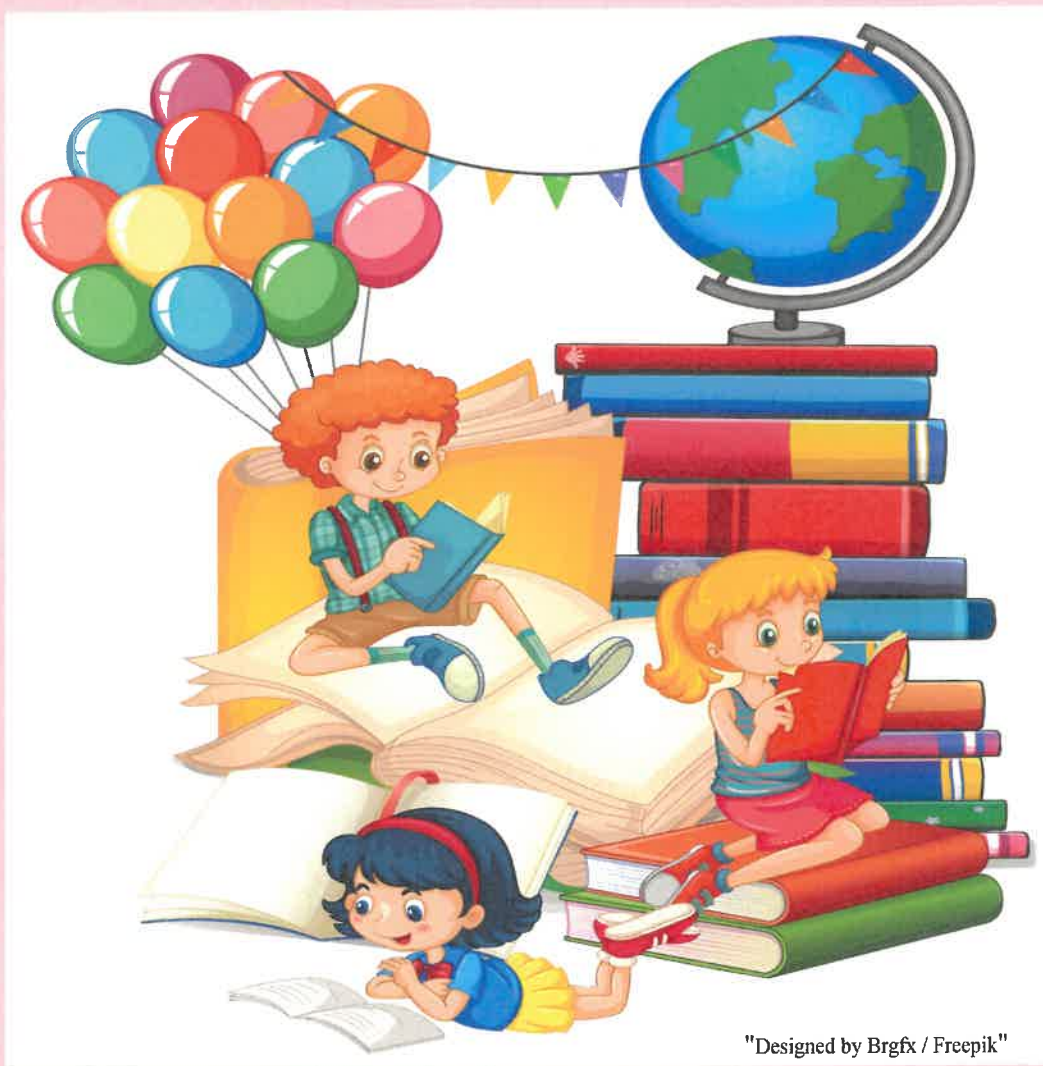
The top three summer readers from each age group will be awarded a special prize
