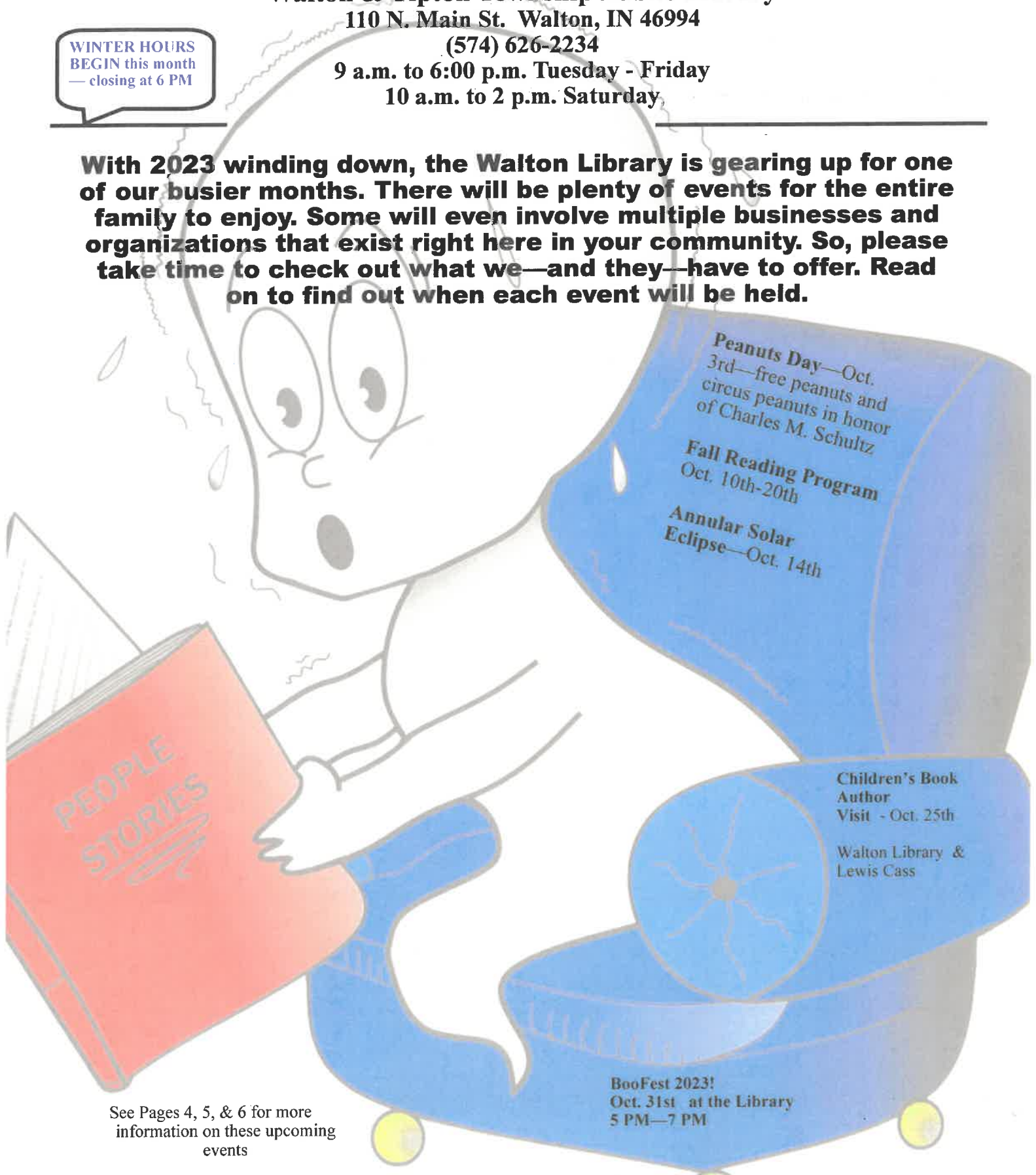

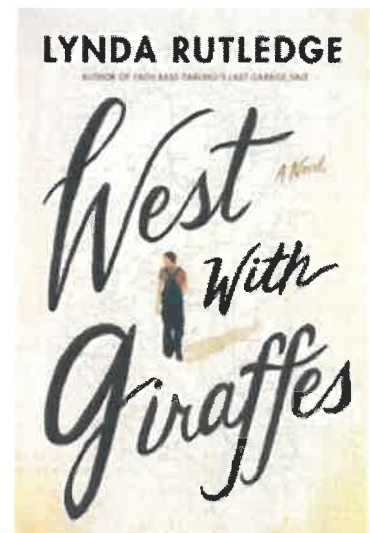

11 a.m. Thursday, Oct. 19th—Local author, Lucy Reyna, will read her book, *A Soldier's Story*. A craft also will be provided.

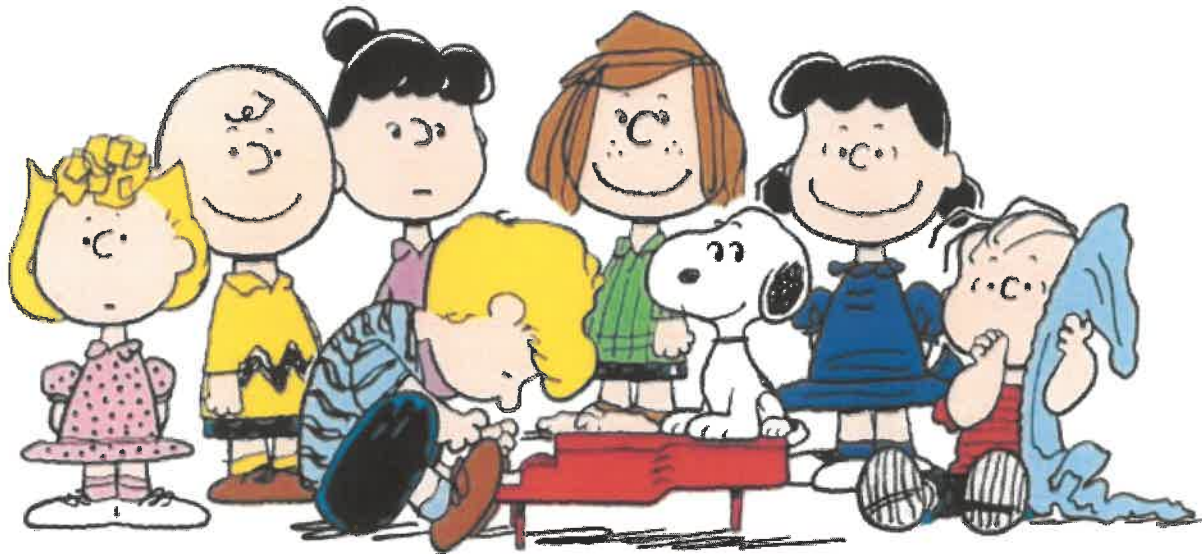

National Peanuts Day—Oct. 2nd

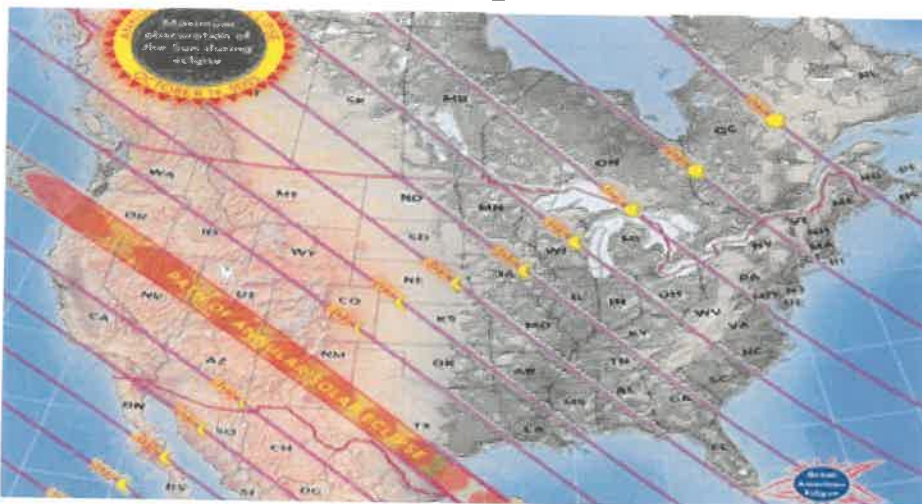


Charles M. Schultz's comic strip, *Peanuts*, was first published on Oct. 2, 1950 in seven newspapers. The final originally written comic was last published in 2000, following Schultz's death. However, it continues to be reprinted in more than 2,600 newspapers.

Over the years, it ran in 75 countries and was published in 21 different languages. More than 335 million people have read the adventures of Charlie Brown and Snoopy.

The Walton Library has a limited number of Solar Viewing Filter glasses available for the community. These glasses are courtesy of the National Center for Interactive Learning, Space Science Institute in Boulder, Colorado, and the *Star* Library Network. Glasses may be picked up at the library starting Tuesday, Oct. 10th.

The Annular Solar Eclipse will be visible in Indiana between approximately 11:30 a.m. until 2:30 p.m. with the peak time around 1 p.m. on Oct. 14th. The next one for Indiana will be in June, 2039.


