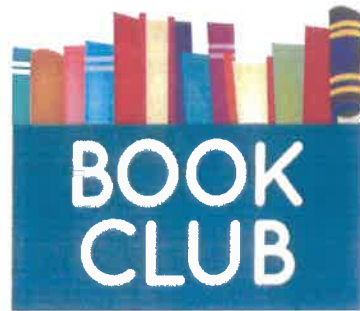


BOARD MEETING

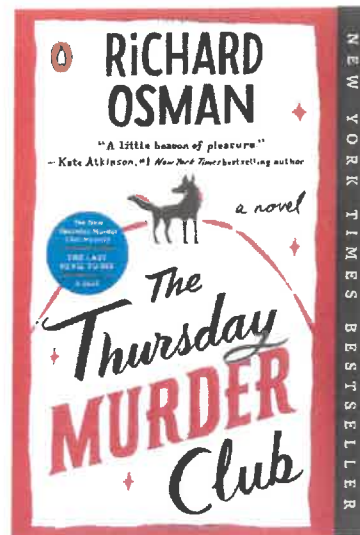

You've asked, and we've listened.

Starting this month, the Walton & Tipton Township Public Library will begin offering Cloud Printing. The service will be provided through Princh, a cloud-based program that will allow patrons to print from laptops, iPads, and cell phones.

We will offer guidance and assistance as the transition to this new service is made. We are not taking away any of the services you are familiar with, which means we will continue to provide printing from the patron desktop computers.

With a vast majority of patrons wanting to print from their cell phones, though, we hope you will find this new option helpful and easy to navigate.



New library technology also includes a 75-inch Samsung Smart Board. This interactive white board features a variety of ways to communicate data. Whether presenting information to a group in the Community Room or taking part in a Zoom meeting, the Smart Board is available for use upon request. A laptop that accompanies the Smart Board also may be used.

Due to the cost associated with the Smart Board, there will be additional requirements that must be met by those who wish to use this device. For more information, please call the library at 574-626-2234.
