He also speaks both English and Spanish.

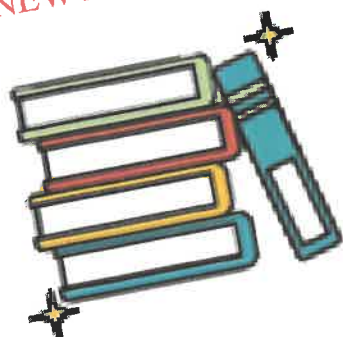


CONGRATULATIONS, BETH SULLIVAN!

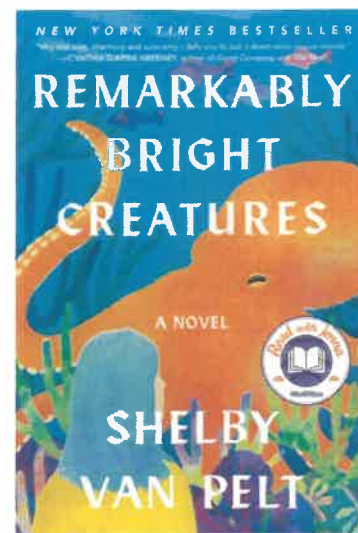

There were 21 children who participated in the Fall Reading Program that ran from October 10th through October 20th.

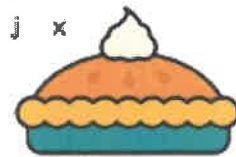
