Stop in during National Library Week for a fun game.

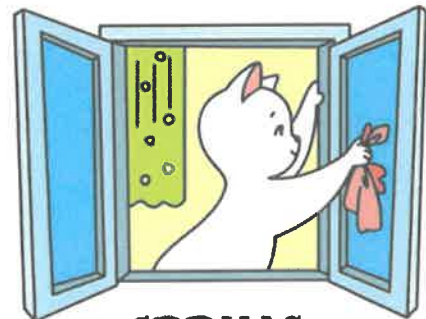
Find out how well you know the people who work at the library by playing a fact-matching game. Three facts are to be matched up with every employee.

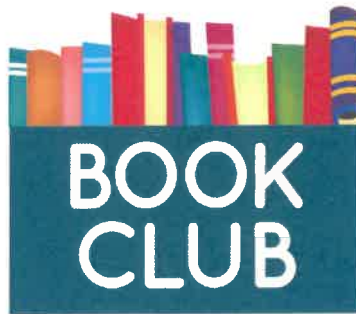

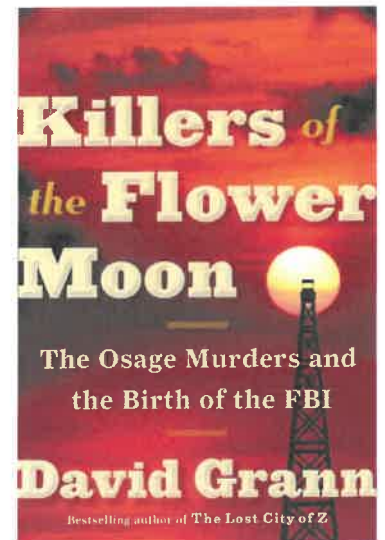

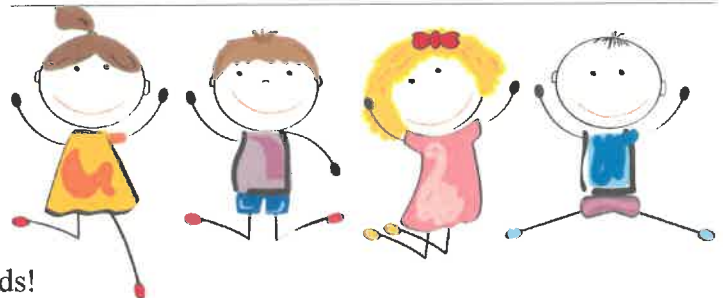
