September is Library Card Sign-Up Month. Libraries focus on expanding their customer base while promoting various ways local public libraries can be used.



- (1) Visit a library employee at the Circulation Desk;
- (2) Return all of your overdue books;
- (3) If you have lost or misplaced any overdue books, pay for the replacement of the book(s); and,
- (4) Your fine will either be forgiven in total or reduced by a percentage.

The fine reductions are as follows:

- \$0.25-\$10.00 (100% forgiven)
- \$10.01—\$20.00 (75% forgiven)
- \$20.01-\$50.00 (50% forgiven)
- \$50.01 or more (case-by-case basis)

Fundraising


All new patrons will have one free entry into the library's "grand prize" drawing once he or she receives a library patron number.






GAMING STATIONS
