If you do all of the activities on the sheet, you'll get a different prize.


March also is Women's History Month

If you are interested in historical books or historical fiction books about women, check out our selection.

Two of our top choices are *The Only Woman in the Room* by Marie Benedict and *The Personal Librarian* by Marie Benedict and Victoria Christopher Murray.

The Only Woman in the Room is an historical fiction novel about actress, Hedy Lamarr. Not only was Hedy a well-known Hollywood star, but she was a scientist. Check out the book to learn what Hedy invented and how her achievements impacted the scientific field.

The Personal Librarian is an historical fiction novel about Belle da Costa Greene, a Black American woman who served as J.P. Morgan's personal librarian. The book details how Greene, who was light-skinned, passed as white to navigate the racist world of early 20th-century America. This gave her the chance to build a powerful career and legacy while hiding her true identity from her family and society. Discover her secrets—check out the book this month.

Our April book will be 'Awe' by Dacher Keltner.



Meetings are held at the board table on the main floor in the adult fiction wing.






