

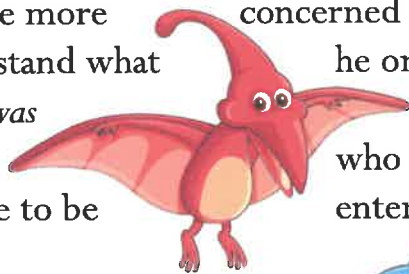

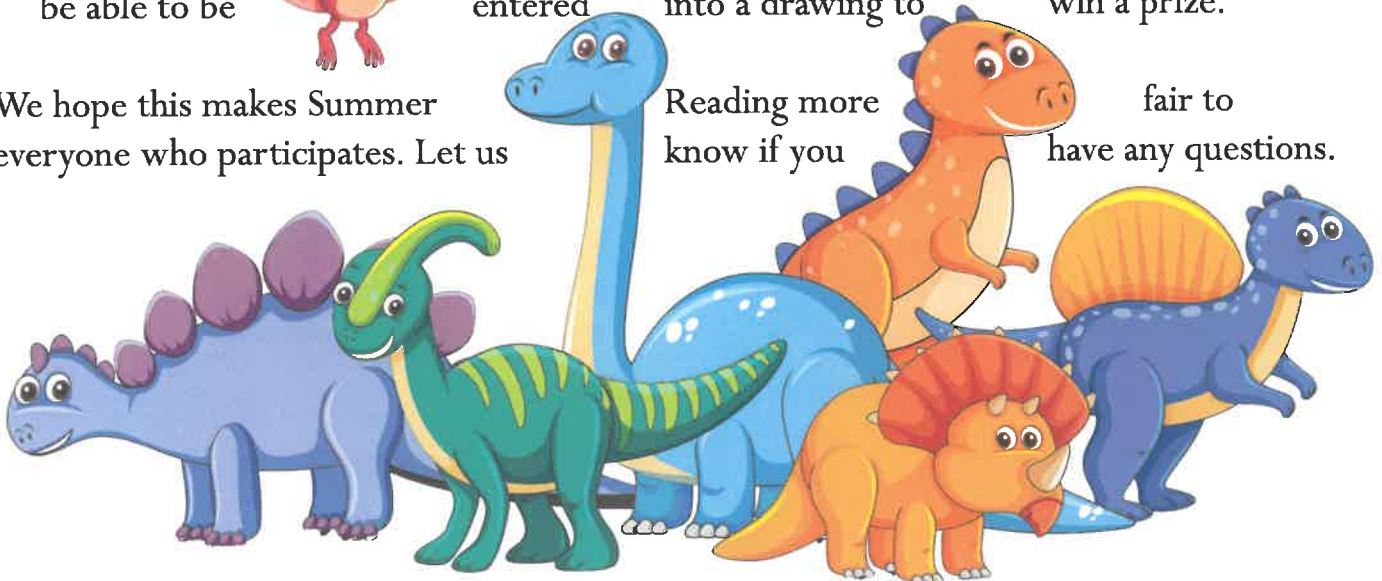
# IT'S THAT TIME! SUMMER READING IS HERE!

We are so excited about this year's program. The theme is fun ... who doesn't like dinosaurs? And we have so many amazing activities planned that you will have something to do every single day of June. **But we also have a new way of operating the program, so please make yourself familiar with the new rules:**

- (1) We no longer are counting top readers.
- (2) Emphasis will be on completing weekly reading requirements, not on the number of books a participant reads.
- (3) Everyone will have an equal chance at winning a prize as long as participants complete each week's required reading ... i.e., the number of books you need to read per week .
- (4) We are more concerned with reading comprehension: does each participant understand what he or she has read? (*Who are the characters? What's the plot? What was the purpose of the story?*).
- (5) All who complete the weekly book reading requirements will be able to be entered into a drawing to win a prize.

Our July book will be *We Will Be Jaguars* by: Nemonte Nenquimo & Mitch Anderson.

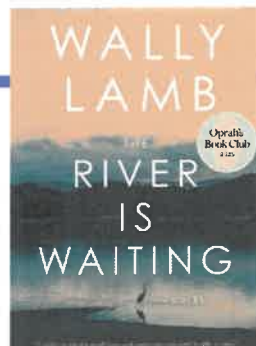

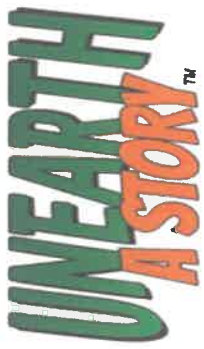


