BOOK CLUB

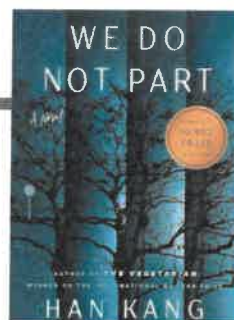
We meet at 1 p.m. every fourth Tuesday of the month unless a special event comes up.

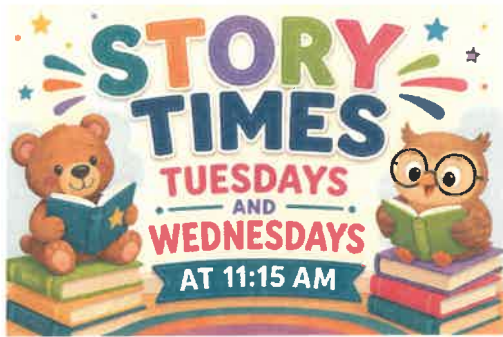
